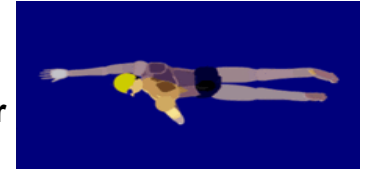

POOL RULES

1. Residents must show valid ID card when entering the pool.
2. Residents must accompany guests at all times.
3. Cover-ups and shoes must be worn to and from the pool and while inside the clubhouse.
4. No food of any kind is allowed in the pool area.
5. Drinks are only permitted in plastic bottles or cans.
6. Smoking is prohibited in the pool area
7. Residents must discard their own trash.
8. Chairs may not be saved or reserved.
9. Umbrellas are to be handled by lifeguards only.
10. Pollution of swimming pool prohibited. Urinating, discharge of fecal matter, expectorating or blowing the nose is prohibited.
11. Any child not toilet trained must wear rubber pants or swimmies while in the pool.
12. No diaper changing is permitted at the pool.
13. Running, jumping and throwing are prohibited.

16. Children under the age of thirteen must be supervised at all times by an adult.
