Snow, snow, snow...

After each snow event, Debeneditis and his crew worked through the night clearing the roadways and shoveling a path to each resident's home. Residents should be aware that is not the responsibility of the contractor or maintenance staffs to remove snow from the patios.

For those residents who moved their cars off the side streets before each event, we thank you. It is extremely important that the side streets be kept free of cars to allow clear access for the plows.

The Village of North Hills now requires homeowners to file for a permit for all interior alterations, other than painting and wallpapering. You must provide an architectural plan for all structural changes to ensure that said modification would not impair the structural soundness of the home of building in which the home is located. It's important that you make sure your contractor is licensed and insured.

If your contractor require a dumpster, you should notify your management office in advance so they can make arrangements to block off an area close to your unit. Dumpsters are permitted for a maximum of five days.

If you are replacing windows, the style, frame construction and color must conform with the existing windows. Also, replacement storm doors must have full view glass with Bronze.
