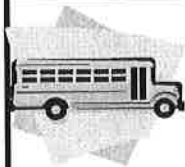


ANNUAL BBQ

GARBAGE DISPOSAL

It has been brought to our attention that garbage is being disposed of improperly.

- Cartons must be broken down, folded and tied together.
- Contractors are responsible to remove debris off-site.
- Carpet must be cut into strips no wider than 3ft. and rolled into bundles that are easy to handle.
- All trash must be contained in sealed plastic bags and placed in covered garbage pails.

Please do not use the dumpster by the clubhouse. Bulk garbage is picked up by our maintenance staff on Mondays and Tuesdays.
