## REMINDER!!

UPDATE YOUR RESIDENT PASSES for the 2013 season and also obtain this year's pool guest pass at the condo office. We strongly urge everyone to update their pool pass prior to pool opening. Anyone who does not have an updated pass will not be admitted.

New residents who have not yet obtained their resident passes, must drop off two photographs for each resident family member and put the individual's name and unit address on the back of each picture and drop them at the condo office. There is a \$2 laminating fee for each pass. Passes are required when using the recreational facilities, gym, tennis courts and pool.

## AIR CONDITIONING SEASON REMINDERS
