A local law to amend the Code of the Village of North Hills, in relation to animals and nuisances.

Section one. Section 100-5 of the Code of the Village of North Hills is hereby amended, to read as follows:

“§ 100-5. Curbing of dogs; removal of feces.

A. No person who owns, possesses, harbors, keeps or is in charge or control of a dog shall cause, suffer, allow or permit any such animal to soil, defile, defecate on or commit any nuisance on any public highway, street, thoroughfare, walk used in common by the public or any place where people congregate, or on any other public property, or on any private property without the permission of the owner or person in possession of said private property. This paragraph shall not be construed to prohibit permitting such animal to soil, defile, defecate or commit a nuisance within the curb lines of a public highway or street, provided that any feces deposited by such animal shall be removed and disposed of as provided in this section.

B. A person owning or possessing or in control of a dog which defecates, urinates or commits any nuisance as prohibited herein, with or without the knowledge, consent or fault of such person, shall be guilty of a violation of this section. It shall be presumed that a dog defecating, urinating or committing a nuisance on private property of a person other than the dog's owner or possessor does so without the consent of the owner or person in possession of such private property.

C. A person who owns, possesses, harbors, keeps or is in charge or control of an animal which deposits any feces on any property in the Village of North Hills shall promptly remove all feces deposited by such animal by placing such feces in a plastic bag which shall be sealed and deposited in a covered garbage receptacle, or by any other sanitary method approved by the Nassau County Department of Health. Any person who fails to remove and dispose of such feces as provided herein shall be guilty of a violation.”

Section two. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this local law shall be held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, or the application of this local law to any person or set of circumstances shall be held invalid, such invalidity or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, or operation of this local law directly involved in the controversy in which the judgment shall have been rendered.

Section three. This law shall take effect immediately upon adoption and filing pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law.
