ACORN PONDS HOA RULES FOR TENNIS COURT USAGE

- 1. PLAY IS LIMITED TO RESIDENTS ONLY
- 2. PLAY IS LIMITED TO SINGLES ONLY
- 3. WHEN USING THE TENNIS SIGN-UP PROGRAM, THE FIRST AND LAST NAMES OF PLAYERS <u>MUST</u> BE INCLUDED
- 4. CHILDREN OF RESIDENTS CAN ONLY SIGN UP UNDER THE RESIDENT'S NAME AND THEY MUST BE OVER THE AGE OF 12
- 5. PLAYERS <u>MUST</u> PROVIDE WIPES AND DISINFECTANTS TO BE USED BEFORE AND AFTER PLAY
- 6. IT IS YOUR REPSONSIBILITY TO WIPE DOWN EVERYTHING YOU TOUCH, INCLUDING THE GATE DOORKNOB AND BROOM/GROOMER HANDLE
- 7. THE CLUBHOUSE WILL REMAIN CLOSED INCLUDING THE RESTROOMS
- 8. PLAYERS <u>MUST</u> BRING THEIR OWN REFRESHMENTS. THE WATER COOLER IS OUT OF SERVICE.
- 9. THE USTA AND NASSAU COUNTY HAVE RECOMMENDED USING TWO CANS OF BALLS WHICH CAN BE MARKED SO YOU ONLY TOUCH YOUR OWN WHEN SERVING.
- 10. LESSONS BY PROS ARE <u>NOT PERMITTED</u>
- 11. IF A PLAYER VIOLATES THE RULES, IN ADDITION TO THE \$200. FINE, HIS/HER TENNIS PRIVILEGES WILL BE SUSPENDED FOR THE BALANCE OF THE TENNIS SEASON
